


Figure 1 – OMX 3 Month Share Price Chart




Figure 2 – Ordinary and Escrowed Shares





LACHLAN FOLD BELT NSW – A WORLD CLASS GOLD REGION



NSW GOLD PROJECT – CALARIE 2021 RC DRILLING



- Ten RC drill holes totalling 1,044 metres were completed at Calarie Project in December 2021
- Drilling was planned to validate historical drill holes and look to extend mineralised horizons intersected in previous drill programs
- High grade significant intercepts from 2021 RC drill programme below:

- Results received give strong confidence that high grade mineralisation extends to depth.
- Phase 2 diamond drilling programme completed in September 2022 intersected the sheared mineralised contact of sediments and volcanics in three deep holes.




Figure 1 - Map of Calarie Drill Results




Figure 1 – Calarie Oblique Section A




Figure 2 – Calarie Oblique Section B




Figure 1 - Calarie Plan of Diamond Drilling Programme Completed September 2022




Figure 2 - Mineralised Parkes Shear OCDD002 (266.0-271.6m)

NSW GOLD PROJECT – CALARIE EXTENSIONS




- Calarie Project area lies on the Parkes Thrust (2.9Moz North Parkes Mine, 108Koz Peak Hill Gold Mine and the 1.8Moz Tomingley Mine).
- Licences covers approximately 21km of the fault.
- Geophysical data and historic drilling have revealed key targets for follow-up drilling.
- Land access negotiations are underway for access to areas prospective for strike extensions of the Calarie Gold Mine.



NSW PROJECT – WISEMANS CREEK



- 4 Exploration Licences approx. 30Km from Bathurst.
- Binding Term Sheet entered into to acquire 100% of EL8554 from Godolphin Resources in March 2022.
- Key project area is Black Bullock Mine:
 - 1900s era gold and silver production
 - Historic drill results include high grade gold and base metals mineralisation.
 - Multiple mineralisation types.
- Diamond drill program completed in May 2022 intersected 24.6m @ 1.3g/t Au from 34.4m in OWCD004.
- Follow-up exploration currently in planning stage.





Figure 1 – Wisemans Creek Section 6273700N




Figure 2 – Wisemans Creek OWCD004 – Core Tray



